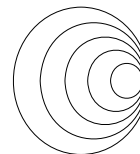

## **BUCKEYE GP HOLDINGS L.P. REPORTS 2007 THIRD QUARTER RESULTS AND INCREASES QUARTERLY DISTRIBUTION**

Breinigsville, PA – October 25, 2007. . . MainLine Management LLC (“MainLine Management”), the general partner of Buckeye GP Holdings L.P. (NYSE:BGH) (“BGH”), today reported financial results for BGH for the third quarter of 2007. BGH’s net income for the third quarter of 2007 was \$5.0 million, or \$0.18 per common unit, compared with net income of \$1.5 million for the third quarter of 2006. Revenue in the third quarter of 2007 increased to \$125.6 million from revenue of \$116.5 million in the third quarter of 2006. Operating income increased in the third quarter of 2007 to \$46.2 million from \$40.3 million in the third quarter of 2006.

BGH owns the general partner interest and incentive distribution rights associated with Buckeye Partners, L.P. (NYSE: BPL) (“BPL”) and reports its financial results on a consolidated basis with the financial results of BPL. BGH currently has no operating activities separate from those conducted by BPL, and its cash flow is derived solely from cash distributions received from BPL and BPL’s subsidiary operating partnerships.

BGH also announced that the Board of Directors of MainLine Management declared a quarterly cash distribution of \$0.265 per common unit, or \$1.06 per common unit on an annual basis, payable on November 30, 2007, to unitholders of record on November 5, 2007. This cash distribution represents an increase in the quarterly distribution of 6.0 percent compared to the quarterly cash distribution of \$0.25 paid in August 2007.

Separately, MainLine Management announced that Stephen C. Muther, Executive Vice President, Administration and Legal Affairs, has been appointed to the position of President of MainLine Management effective as of October 25, 2007. Mr. Muther has held

positions of increasing responsibility with BPL and MainLine Management since he joined BPL in 1990. Mr. Muther will continue to report to Forrest E. Wylie, Chief Executive Officer of MainLine Management.
